Each student will come home with a first day envelop with a newsletter and other important information. Please read and return all documents as soon as possible.

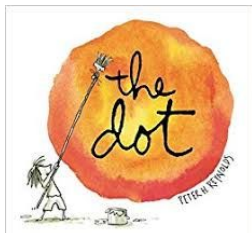
